



REGULATIONS OF THE "WAIKIKI WATER PARK"

The Management reserves the right to close the park at any time due to adverse weather conditions, for the safety and protection of everyone.

The management reserves the right to remove dangerous objects or people whose behavior does not comply with the stipulated regulations, and to close the floating aqua park at any time, without notice, for the safety and protection of everyone.

1. customers accept the following regulations and undertake to observe them, thereby relieving the company MALÙ SRL _ CONTINENTAL CAMPING VILLAGE from liability of any kind;
2. The WATER PARK is open from 11:00 to 18:00. With red flag the park is closed;
3. Play sessions last for maximum 50 minutes;
4. The last play session of the day starts at 17:00;
5. The WATER PARK is open to all adults who can swim;
6. Admission is open to all children over the age of six and with a height of more than one meter ten centimeters (110 cm);
7. Children from 6 to 12 years of age and/or with a height of 140 cm must be accompanied by an adult (18+) who assumes all responsibility for the child with a written declaration;
8. The water park staff and/or the Lifeguard regulate customers' admission by allowing them access to the inflatables from the entrance jetty;
9. Except at the Management's discretion, disabled individuals who are not self-sufficient are only allowed admission if accompanied by an adult (18+) and with the prior authorization of the pool attendant;
10. Admission to the park is in accordance with the methods indicated;
11. In compliance with the provisions of these rules and with legal regulations, by requesting admission to the park, customers accept without reservation that safety checks may be carried out on their person and their clothes;
12. The Management reserves the right to deny entry to those who intend to prevent such inspections and checks and may report the facts to the competent authority;
13. The Management of the park wishes to clarify that by inspection and safety check they mean a limited check on the customer's person and the personal items in their possession, in order to ascertain whether there are any objects present which might offend or violate others' personal safety, or damage third party items and goods;
14. The Management reserves the right to deny admission, to or remove from the park, anyone who does not comply with the regulations or causes annoyance and/or harm to others.
15. A maximum number of 70 people are allowed to be in the water park at the same time;
16. Each customer is provided with a life jacket at the park entrance which should be returned to the point where it was handed to them;
17. The life jacket cannot be removed during the session nor be transferred to third parties;
18. The water park will be closed in the event of bad weather.
19. In the event of adverse weather conditions, the Management will immediately close the park, in order to protect everyone's safety;
20. There are staff members and/or the Lifeguard within the park for the safety of all our customers, but they cannot be considered a substitute for the constant supervision of children, this being the responsibility of the parents or whoever is responsible for them;
21. The following are not allowed to enter: children under six years of age and under 110 cm in height, people who CANNOT SWIM, pregnant women, those with pacemakers or

- subcutaneous defibrillators, and those affected by totally disabling conditions which prevent them making use of the amusement;
22. Anyone who does not declare their state of health or condition when using the equipment in the water park is responsible for any possible risk which derives from this use, and for any possible harm which might be caused to their own person or to third parties;
 23. Animals are not allowed to enter the water park;
 24. Behavior contrary to the Public Safety regulations is strictly prohibited; this includes, for example, taking and dealing drugs, harassing or disturbing other people, drunkenness;
 25. It is also strictly forbidden to bring any object or substance into the water park which might cause harm to people or objects, or to the structure of the park itself (hairpins, scissors, knives, glasses, cans, glass, metals, watches, bracelets, earrings, rings, cameras and any object deemed inappropriate by the Management). Anyone who does not follow the instructions of the park staff regarding objects which must be left behind, or removed from the body before entering the park, will be denied admission;
 26. The consumption of food and drinks is absolutely forbidden during play sessions;
 27. Customers must observe the instructions given by the lifeguards and /or the water park staff with the utmost attention and diligence and a minimum safety distance from other people must always be maintained;
 28. Swimming under the inflatable equipment is strictly forbidden;
 29. Diving where other people are swimming is forbidden;
 30. Entering the water park at night and outside opening hours is forbidden;
 31. Smoking is forbidden inside the marine water park;
 32. Customers must always refrain from behavior which might offend the personal dignity of those in the water park;
 33. Anyone who has parental responsibility for or is a guardian of a child who enters the water park by falsely declaring their age, assumes responsibility for any possible risk that which might derive from this declaration, and for any possible harm which the child might cause to itself or to third parties while using the park's equipment;
 34. All objects found unattended must be handed to Campsite Reception;
 35. The Management is not responsible for objects left unattended;
 36. The Management declines all responsibility for accidents or harm to persons and belongings caused by carelessness, negligence or failure to comply with the "water park safety rules";
