


**Before starting your holiday in our campsite, please read carefully our pricelist and the following rules.**



At arrival, you are all asked to hand in a **VALID PASSPORTS OR IDENTITY CARD** which is necessary for police registration. The management reserves the right to hold these documents until full payment of the bill or until your departure.



At the check-in every person receives the **CAMPING PASS**, a personal card on which you can find: your name, your day of arrival and departure, your place or accommodation number. Please check them carefully and inform immediately the reception in case of disagreement. The camping pass has to be shown: at the payment, at the reception for any changing or any information about your stay and on request of the security staff of the campsite.



In order to guarantee your security and a better control inside the campsite, everybody must always wear the **CONTINENTAL BRACELET**.



Guests have always to inform the reception staff in case of an **EARLIER OR TEMPORARY DEPARTURE**. Without communications, the whole period will be charged.




It is not possible to pay cash or by credit card inside the camping (bar, restaurant, supermarket, etc.). The only way of payment is by **PAY CARD** (an electronic system of payment). You receive the card at the check-in and for each one is required a deposit. On departure, the outstanding credit and the deposit will be paid back.



**NO ENTRANCE FOR UNAUTHORIZED PERSONS.** People found inside the camping without previous registration/authorization by the reception will be denounced for house-breakings as per art. 614 of the Italian penal code.



**A VISIT** of friends or relatives is allowed only upon delivery of an identity card and payment of a daily ticket.



**NO ACCESS IN THE SWIMMING POOL FOR DAILY VISITORS OR OUTSIDERS.**



The places and accommodations are assigned by the reception. For internal organizational reasons, it is strictly forbidden to change place without previous authorization from the reception.



Please respect the **COMPLETE SILENCE FROM 23.00 TO 08.00 O’CLOCK**. It is a good rule to limit the noises also in daytime and avoid all behaviours which can trouble the quiet and peace of other customers.



Drive with caution and don’t exceed the speed limit inside the camping of **5 KM/H**.



**DOGS** are allowed in the camping pitches (in high season only on request and upon reservation) but not in our accommodation. They must be kept on a leash and they are not allowed: on the beach, in the lake, supermarket, pool, arena, children’s playground, tennis and soccer fields.



According to the new anti-fire regulations, **YOUR TENTS/CARAVANS MUST BE PLACED** in the middle of the pitch, at least 1 meter far from the border, so that there will be 2 meters distance between the 2 units. Please remember that also your car must be parked on the pitch.



Any **ADDITIONAL CLOTH** or **LARGE PIECES OF CANVAS** are not accepted because of their bad environmental impact. Before placing a gazebo on the pitch, guests must take in consideration the parking space for their car.



According to the new anti-fire law guests have to pay attention to their **GAS BOTTLES**: only one gas bottle per pitch is allowed and it is forbidden to leave it in the sun. Guests have to check the gas pipe frequently.



**CHARCOAL GRILLS ARE ALLOWED BUT NOT PERMITTED DIRECTLY ON YOUR PITCHES/ OR DIRECTLY NEXT TO YOUR ACCOMMODATION.**



Everybody must follow the rules about the **RUBBISH COLLECTION**, which is mandatory in our territory. Rubbish must be separated with care in each special container (glass, paper, plastic, cans, organic waste). In case of non-observance of these rules, in accordance with the Italian law, you will have to pay a fine from € 50,00 to € 150,00.



The cleanliness of the **TOILETS** depends also on you. Help us to keep them clean.



**IT’S STRICTLY FORBIDDEN TO THROW DIRTY WATER IN THE STREET DRAINS**, because it flows directly to the lake.



You have to respect the vegetation, the hygiene and the cleanliness of the campsite.



The campsite declines all responsibility for theft or damage. Guests are responsible for their own property.



The management will immediately expel any guest caught damaging or spoiling the camping’s toilets or equipment’s. Adults are responsible for the behaviour of their children and the teen-agers that are under their care. They have to make sure that they do not disturb the quietness and the security of the other guests. Otherwise the whole family will be expelled from the campsite.



The management reserves the right to expel any guest who disregards the above rules or behave in any way that is likely to disturb the other guests.
